

# Te Tohu Hāpai: Criteria for consideration by the Selection Panel

## Key Concepts

He Ngakaunui – Dedication / Commitment to tennis

He Manaakitanga nui – Care / Impact on tennis

Kaitiakitanga – Stewardship / Guardian of tennis

## Demonstration

Exceptional level of voluntary service (committees, boards)

Sustained service 'over and above' paid employment

Sustained commitment to national teams (players)

Significant leadership actions to look after community

Widely respected as a role model bringing mana to tennis

Mentoring, Team Leadership

Roles of high responsibility (eg chairperson)

Significant leadership actions to enable future success

### Notes:

- *Such recognition (Ngakaunui) roles within the sport can be evident broadly across all forms of the sport, being service to the sport over a lengthy period of time, and include playing of the sport, administration, officiating, coaching and volunteering. The Honour rewards voluntary service, so only the voluntary component of service will be considered. The panel will use its discretion in cases where modest honoraria have been paid for service.*
- *Within these paramount benchmarks (paearu) the Honour reflects dedication to and love of the sport, selfless commitment to its advance, making a difference and enhancing the sport for those around them for future generations.*
